
Who participated?

- 113 total fellows participated from a variety of different subspecialties
- 20-25% of all Orthopedic fellows responded

- 35% cited a work life balance


Why did they choose their department for the Fellowship?




Evaluation of their department

- 98% stated the fellowship improved surgical skills and judgment
- 93% said they were appropriately mentored
- 90% said they had the appropriate operative case load/mix
- 82% said the department embraces diversity, 86% said they were happy with work/life balance
- 80+% said the comradery between residents, fellows and faculty is healthy




Areas that stand out that needs to be better to prepare fellows to enter into practice


